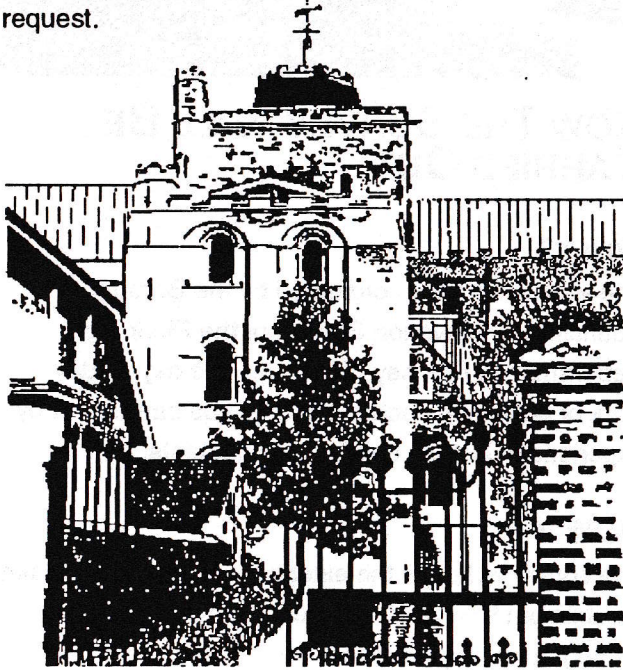


## YOUR HELP

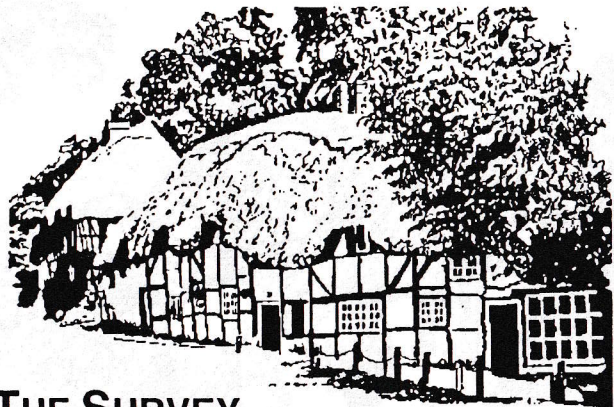

Test Valley Borough Council, in conjunction with Hampshire County Council and English Heritage, are carrying out a survey of all Listed Buildings and structures within the Borough this year.

As an owner or occupier of a Listed Building we are seeking your co-operation in ensuring the success of this survey.



## THE SURVEY

Listed Buildings are those which since 1947 have been identified as being of special architectural or historic interest, and which as a nation we should conserve for the benefit of future generations.

Test Valley has over 2,000 Listed Buildings, of all ages and types of construction, each one contributing to the unique character of the Borough.

There has not, however, been a comprehensive survey of the condition of these buildings.

It is intended that our survey will:

- Give a better understanding of the general condition of the stock of Listed Buildings
- Help us to target assistance such as technical advice and/or grant assistance to those buildings which require repair before it is too late
- Contribute to a national survey of historic buildings being carried out by English Heritage



## HOW THE SURVEY WILL BE CARRIED OUT

### WHO ?

The survey will be co-ordinated by the Borough Council's Conservation Section of the Planning Department in Romsey. However, the day-to-day work of surveying each building will be carried out by experienced historic buildings consultants.

### HOW ?

The survey will be of the exterior only and should take a maximum time of 20 minutes. Some exterior photographs may be taken.

The survey is based on visual observation only, and no information will be required from the owners/occupiers.

### WHEN ?

A surveyor will be visiting your property in the near future.
