



St. Mary's Church, Broughton, Hampshire

St Mary's Church Broughton

The earliest building for which evidence exists was a 12th century church without aisles. These were added at the end of the 12th century. In about 1220 the Nave was lengthened westwards and the present West Door was built. The tower was built in the 15th century and now houses six bells dated 1617, 1618, 1763, 1779 and 1934.

In the churchyard is a columbarium, or dove cote which belonged to the Rectory from 1341, and formed part of the endowment. The present structure dates from the time of William and Mary (1689 - 1702)

1. THE BUILDINGS.

Cattle yard of old downland farm provides sheltered setting for old fashioned roses and shrubs. New pergola this year. Fine views over Broughton and the Downs.

2. NORTHACRE.

A semi-formal garden with many attractive features, including a fish pond, rockery, rose beds, herbaceous and shrub borders. Small greenhouse and well stocked kitchen garden.

3. KING COTTAGE.

A medium-sized garden with old fashioned and other roses, shrubs and ground cover, a small gravel garden and fishpond. Some recently replanted areas.

4. MEADOWBROOK HOUSE.

Approximately 3 acres of garden laid to lawn and shrubs. Formal Japanese Koi pond, rockeries and lake with wild fowl.

5. THE OLD COACH HOUSE.

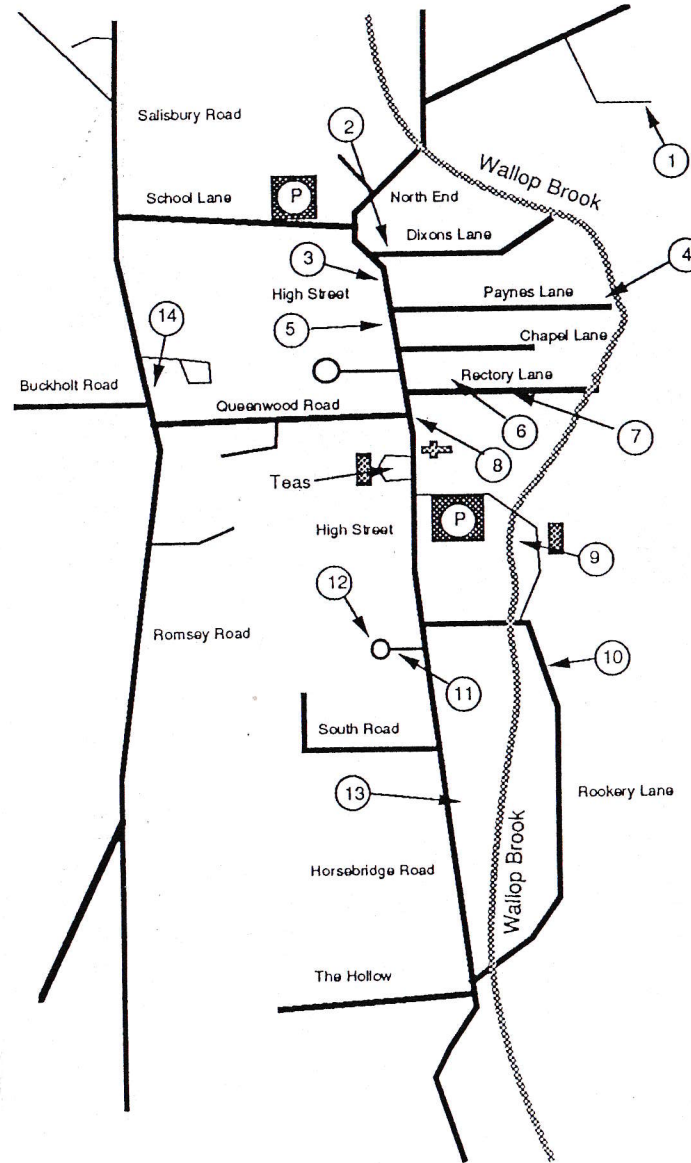
This small informal garden is "under development". It has mixed borders of shrubs and herbaceous with a few treasures.

6. THE OLD RECTORY.

A $\frac{3}{4}$ acre mature garden with many flowering shrubs, roses and herbaceous plants. An old Bakehouse within a small garden and colourful swimming pool area.

7. ST MARY'S COTTAGE.

A mature informal walled garden of half an acre, with trees, including a very old Quince, shrubs and a pond.



8. YEW TREE HOUSE.

Created over the last five years, this walled garden has long double borders full of annuals and perennials with some unusual plants.

9. BROUGHTON HOUSE.

Years ago this was a large garden, now changed to informal grounds. Lovely peaceful setting with lawns, trees and shrubs. The Wallop Brook runs through.

10. THE VINE HOUSE.

A mature carefully designed garden covering an acre planted with ornamental shrubs and trees.

11. KERR CRAIG.

A seven year old small garden planted despite builder's rubble. Roses, shrubs, pond, trees and a green conservatory.

12. MAYFIELD.

This garden was started about 5 years ago. The design uses many curves and a variety of surfaces and features to create interest.

13. MILL HOUSE.

Medium sized garden with nice trees, herbaceous borders, rose garden and walled garden. Riverside walk.

14. WY WURRI.

Small garden designed for growing vegetables for exhibition at national championship level.
