

Identification: Possibly the son of Elizabeth ^{and} HATTHAD JOHN HATTHAD, d. 1654 & 1661 respectively. Char: Hall of Broughton.

Evidence: Broughton registers.

Died:

Certified the registers at the end of 1664, 1665, 1666 at Broughton as one of the Church Wardens. His co-signatories were sometimes ranked as "gent." but not Robert.

Letter from M. H. F. Steel - Smith, 16 NOV 1983: "In a document, then in the library of Broughton Baptist Church (1902), and copied by my great-uncle, whose family then owned "Grandfather's" and whose cousin owned Broughton House, one of the "Seats of the Meeting House":

March 9th, 1669 Indenture of Sale by Robert Hatthatt HATTHATT yeoman to William STEELE, Carpenter of 30 Rugs of ground bounded E by Street, W by Townfields, South by Tenement of Wm. Dozells, N by Close of Robt. Hatthatt, for 6.15s consideration.

I have not seen this document, though there is no reason to doubt its authenticity. William Steel was one of my ancestors, dying at Broughton in 1680."

The name of ROBERT HATTHAD appears in a property transfer indenture dated 27 DEC 1680 ref. HQO 72M 80 attached. As he apparently had descendants, it follows he was married & had children.
