

DESCENT FROM SOME EARLY BROUGHTON HATTATTS.

HOWTAT/HUTGT John (JHA 01) Evidence Hay subsidy rolls

1594 John Howtat goods to value £3.

1598 John Hutgt ? as above

This could be the same person as JHA T12.

HATTIAD John of Br. Buried Br. 14 Oct 1661 JHA 02.

Elizabeth, possibly wife of above. Buried at Br. 14 Apr 1654

HATTHAD Dorothy of Br. Possibly dau of 02. Buried at Br. 6 Aug 1672.

WATTS Anne nee HATED. Possibly dau of 02. Married Lawrence Watts at Weyhill in 1672.

HATTHAD John I of Br. Yeoman. 07 Husband of Joanne Hatthad. Possibly son of John Hattiad (02). Br. Registers. Buried Br. 27 Jan 1681.

Issue John and Henry.

1674 certified registers as Churchwarden - John Hatthad.

1673 and 1674 owed for one hearth in Br. Hearth tax.

Joane. Wife of above. Married, issue included

John, baptized 26 Jul 1671. Henry bapt 8 Dec 1673.

Died 12 Apr 1708. (Large says Dec, as a widow).

HATTATT Sarah, buried at Br. 26 Apr 1686. Possibly sister or in-law.

HAWTUT Edward of Br. Married at St. Michaels, Winchester 17 Nov 1663, to Joan Pyle of Wallop. Possibly son of 02.

KING Sarah, nee Hattatt, married at Br. 24 Dec 1700 to Roger King jun. Issue William 9 Oct 1718 and possibly Roger c1703 who was buried at Br. 28 Mar 1765.

JAMES/JONES Elizabeth nee Hathad, possibly dau of 02. Married Henry at Br. 6 Apr 1657. (Large says Jones and 1663.)

HR072M80 Indenture of 1680, John Bedford of Br. sold to Thomas Thomas of Hursley for £46, close of pasture known as Close estimated three score leags with dwelling house lately erected with outhouses backsides, situate in Br. bounded against Street eastward, the fields westward, against a belonging to Southerforde Farm North and against a house and platt of ground of James Hayter. Paying yearly 6 pence to heirs and assigns of Robert Hattatt late of Br. (Incomplete transcription.)

HATTATT Henry, Yeoman of East Tytherley, JHA A11. Younger son of John H II. Bapt at Br. 25 Mar 1713. m 10 Jul 1739 bachelor Yeoman of East Tytherley at St Thomas, Winchester to Sarah Wickham 24 spinster of Br.

Although only infants he and his brother John III became formal tenants of Michelton on death of father in 1714 and mother in 1717. Henry signed Br. Churchwarden's registers 1740 onwards.

HRO 2M59/32 Michelton, occ H.H. of E.T. tenancy to J.H. III and son H.Hattatt Sarah wife of above, buried 18 Mar 1744 at Br.
