Robert Aitken gives J.H.(M) as 157 ac and J.H.(F) as 100 ac in list, the total is correct but distribution incorrect. Henry H. as 12ac is correct. He comments 'The two Hattatts have not yet been completely distinguished.' He mentions '? another J.H.(M) at Upper End'.

J.H.(F) lived at Meanwell's [now Sanford House] and had a malthouse at the Gardens. He was assessed at 6/- for an inclosure in Rookery Lane. Also Rookery Farm 152.

J.H.(M) lived at Mares [Warren Cott] and had a malthouse and shop in The Square; he was also assessed in respect of No. 188 near Frog Moor Marsh (now Hayters Farm) [? wrong H. for 188]

Henry Hattatt lived in the High St. at Davies' garage. [Now Old Coach House.]

"It looks as if Numerical Survey allotments 184,187, and 188 were looked on jointly as the Homestead mentioned." [Hayters Farm.]
